Elections Dates

Primary Elections - third Tuesday in May, even-numbered years
General Elections - Tuesday after the first Monday in November, even-numbered years
Municipal Elections - same time as statewide general elections
County Elections - same time as statewide primary, general elections
Special District Elections - second Tuesday in March or third Tuesday in May, odd-numbered years
Special Elections - ballots delivered to voters in district by mail

Voter Registration

You may register to vote if you are:

- A citizen of the United States
- At least 18 years of age
- A resident of Oregon for at least 20 days before the election

Forms for registration are available at most banks, public schools, libraries, post offices, Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) and also available at Secretary of State's website at www.sos.state.or.us

Registration: If you are a new resident in the State of Oregon, you may register up to the 21st day before an election. If you are already registered in the State of Oregon, you can change your name and address, updating your registration up to the date of the election. However, ORS 247.203 only allows changing your political affiliation up to the 21st day before a primary election.
